## **INJUNCTION**

INJUCTION – Co-ownership of property – whether and when injunction can issue against a co-owner – OBASOHAN V OMORODION 2001 89 LRCN.

INJUNCTION – PROTECTS EXISTING RIGHTS– Injunction is granted to protect an existing legal right with the object of keeping matters in *status quo* – UNION BEVERAGES LTD V PEPSI COLA INTERNATIONAL LTD 1994 3 NWLR 1.

<u>INJUNCTION</u> – MEANING – WHEN GRANTED – To protect a legal right. To restrain the defendant from the repetition or the continuance of the wrongful act – ADENUGA V ODUMERU 2001 83 LRCN 64.

INJUNCTION – COMPLETED ACT – Order of injunction cannot restrain a completed act – KOKORO-OWO V LAGOS STATE GOVT. 2001 87 LRCN 1889; INCAR NIG V BOLEX ENT 2001 87 LRCN 1933.
